The Hudson Police Department is pleased to announce a newly formed partnership with Total Security Inc. of Manchester, New Hampshire; along with Centra-Larm, a New Hampshire based central monitoring station; and DMP which is a manufacturing company that builds American made security products. The SAVE program (Security Against Violence Effort) was designed by Total Security to combat domestic violence.

Together they have brought residents in the Town of Hudson a home panic alarm system for victims of domestic violence. A panic alarm system will be loaned to the victim free of charge. When activated, the alarm summons police to the residence in the event an intruder enters the property contrary to orders to stay away from the victim.

Recipients of the system are referred by officers to the victim witness advocate. The program is in place and is currently being utilized. The program is in place for victims that are in imminent danger and fear for their safety. The program is not set up to be a security system to protect property; it is to protect the victim's safety.
